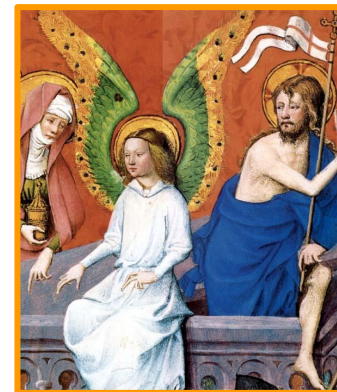

Let us pray.

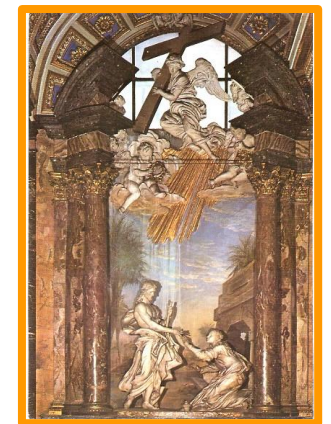
