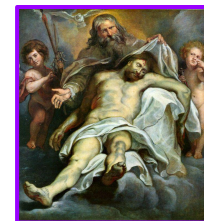

The Most Holy Winding-Sheet

Luke xxiii. 53: "And taking Him down, he wrapped Him in fine linen and laid Him in a sepulchre."

The glories of that sacred Winding-Sheet let every tongue record, which from the Cross received, with honour meet the Body of the Lord. - V. Has risen, as He said, alleluia.
- R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.
- V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.
- R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

O God, Who gave joy to the world through the Resurrection of Thy Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of His Mother, the Virgin Mary, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.
