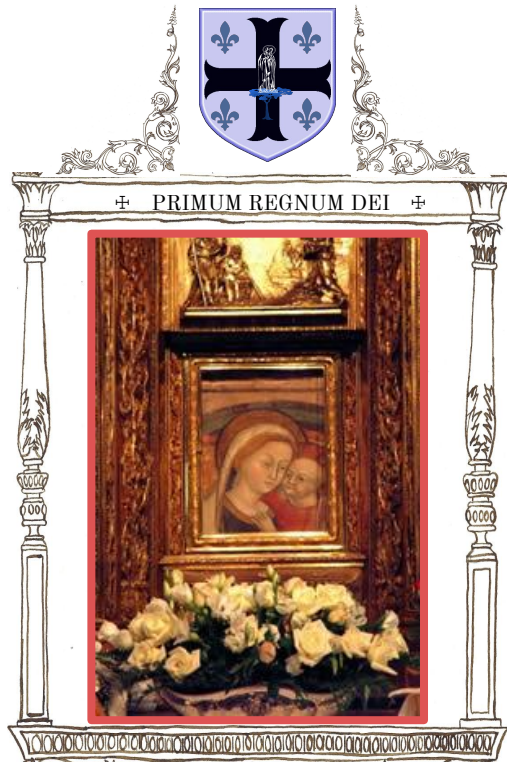


## WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

**THEOLOGY CLASS** - We WILL have class THIS Wednesday. All those who are to be confirmed in July please attend and bring all the required documents and homework. After the Confirmation we plan to study several Papal documents of St. Pius X and Bd. Pius IX.

**FIRST COMMUNION** - Any of the children who are prepared for receiving Our Lord in First Communion need to be ready. Please talk to or email Canon. He will tell you what is needed. The First Communion will be the first Sunday in June.

**MAY CROWNING** - As usual we will do this before the High Mass on Mother's Day, May 9. All the girls of the Parish can take part. They should wear white dresses and mantillas.

**MASSES** - Beginning with the first week of May we will try a new Mass schedule. Masses will continue at 6PM on TUESDAYS, WEDNESDAYS AND THURSDAYS. They will go back to the 8 AM slot on MONDAYS AND FRIDAYS. Any other changes will be announced before it happens.

**MAY 13** - Since it falls on a Thursday, we shall include our Rosary and Low Mass and Benediction in this year's program for honoring Our Lady. Please be here! It also happens to be Ascension Thursday, a holy day of obligation for us Traditionalist Catholics. Of course, it is a Plenary Indulgence day!

**FIRST SATURDAY** - Next Saturday is the first of the month of May, Mary's Month. There will be Low Mass followed by Novena to Our Lady of Fatima and Benediction starting at 8 AM. There will be Acolyte practice afterwards. Those who wish to go to Confession can do so after the Practice.

**LADIES SODALITY** - The Ladies' Sodality will have their monthly meeting NEXT Saturday in the Canon Pérez Hall after the Mass and Benediction. ALL Ladies of the Parish are invited and encouraged to come.
