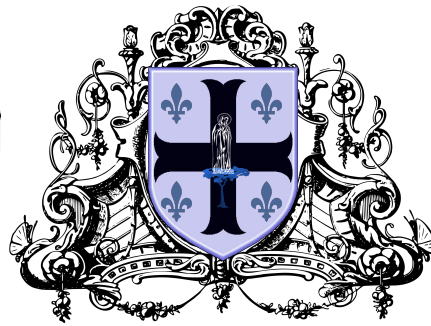


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

PRAYER TO WARD OFF HURRICANES AND STORMS



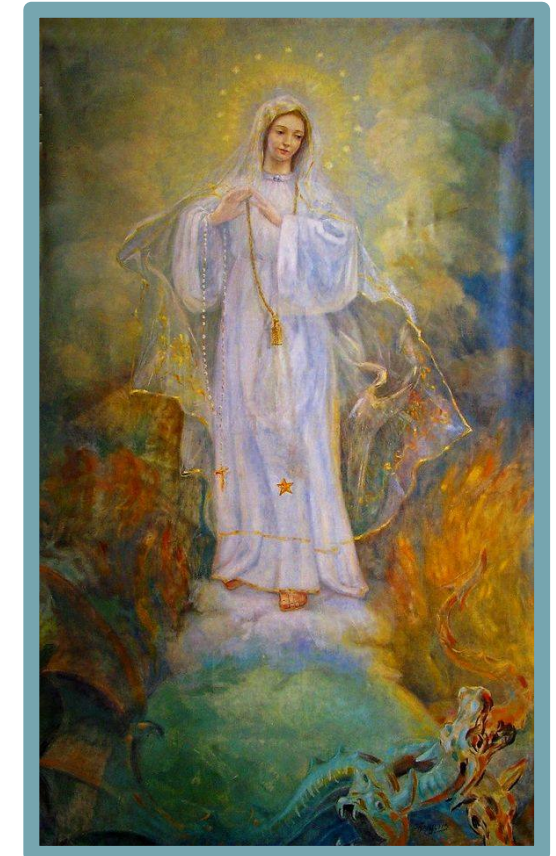
