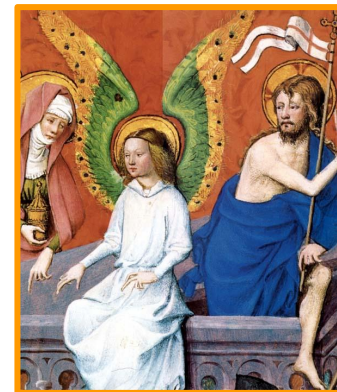

Let us pray.

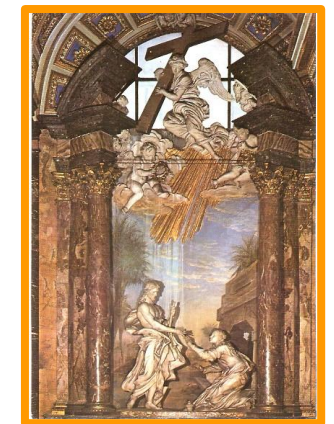
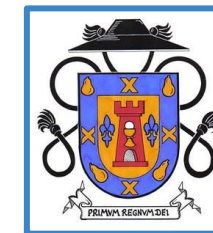
