

BURSE CLUB - This week we will start our drive for the Burse Club for the education of future Priests for our Diocese and Shrine. Begun by a group of ladies in the 1920's, including our first Organist, Katherine Geist Marques, it has helped to pay for the seminaries. The "dues" are \$12 per year. As always Rev. Canon will start it off by giving ten times, \$120. He challenges all to match or better him. The Bishop says several of our Seminarians are interested in praying the Gregorian Rite of the Mass, for our future. Let us assist!

FIRST FRIDAY - This coming Friday is the First Friday of the month of August dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. As usual, we will have Low Mass on Thursday at 6 PM, followed by Novena to the Infant of Prague and Holy Hour in Reparation; Prayer for the Shrine and Parish; and for Vocations. Rosary will be at 5:30 PM.

FIRST SATURDAY - This coming Saturday is First Saturday. We will have Low Mass at 8 AM followed by Novena to Our Lady of Fatima and Benediction. It will be followed by Acolyte Practice. The Ladies' Sodality will have their monthly meeting in the Hall.

HOLY DAY - This year the Feast of the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven happens to fall on a Sunday. All things being equal we will have our customary High Mass at 10:30 AM after the Holy Rosary. It is a very special day for this Diocese as it was on this day in 1559 that Spanish Priests celebrated a Solemn High Mass on Pensacola Beach. It was the first Mass in the continental United States. Let us beseech Our Lady to right the serious errors going on in the Church.

CSA - We remind everyone that it is necessary to participate in the CSA. Now that we have reached our goal, all funds that are collected will go to our savings account for our own needs.

LEGION OF MARY - The Legion of Mary, one of the top and most important apostolates of the Church throughout the world, will celebrate its Hundredth Anniversary this year on Tuesday, September 7th. We will have a Low Mass, Tessera prayers and Rosary with Benediction, starting at 6 PM. ALL are invited. There will be a short reception in the Hall afterwards. ## Words of Advice from the Servant of God, Louis Cardinal Luçon, Archbishop of Reims, France

"People call for the moral revival of the country. The current fashions were certainly not dreamed up and launched with the aim of contributing to this end. Born of corruption, they are one of the most effective agents of moral depravity. They are, in and of themselves, a provocation to evil, a stimulant to the passions. No one can in good faith maintain that they are harmless... Through sanctifying grace we become temples of the Holy Spirit; through Holy Communion we become living sanctuaries of the divine Eucharist. Does this not require of us dress always worthy of the Divine Guests Who deign to honor us with Their visit and Their permanent Presence?... If there is a place in which immodest fashions and revealing dress are particularly inappropriate, is it not the House of God? Is it not an inexcusable lack of respect, not to mention a defiance or insult to the sanctity of God, to enter His Temple, and above all to approach His sacraments in suchmanifestly immodest attire?"
