
WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

BURSE CLUB - Last weekend our Ladies' Sodality started collecting donations for the Burse Club, one of whose Founders was the first organist of this Parish in 1922, Katherine Margues Geist. The DCCW gave the Bishop over \$200,000 this year for the education of future Priests for this Diocese. They ask just \$12 a year. We challenge everyone to make it \$120. The Canon will start it off as usual. Though there are still many problems with the education of Priests, it has improved a thousandfold in the last 20 years!
