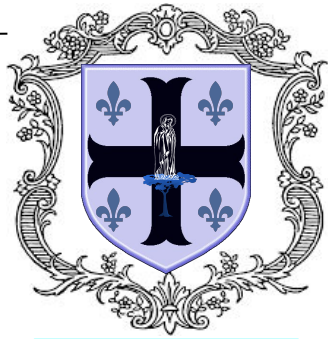


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE

PARISH WEBSITE - Have you checked our parish website lately? Not only can you listen (again) to the Rev. Canon's Sermons, but also in the Links section you can find literally a ton of information about the Catholic Faith and moral life as well as many helps for family life.

BURSE CLUB - Soon our Ladies' Sodality will start collecting donations for the Burse Club, one of whose Founders was the first organist of this Parish in 1922, Katherine Marques Geist. The DCCW gave the Bishop over \$200,000 this year for the education of future Priests for this Diocese. They ask just \$12 a year. We challenge everyone to make it \$120. The Canon will start it off as usual. Though there are still many problems with the education of Priests, it has improved a thousandfold in the last 20 years!

CONFIRMATION - Bishop Wack has agreed to come to our Parish and to bestow the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Gregorian Rite to those who are ready. Canon Pérez will meet with those parents interested. No date or time had been set at this point. No age limits have been set by him yet either...

HOLY DAY - Recall that August 15th, this year a Saturday, is a Holy Day of Obligation. ALL Catholics are to participate at Holy Mass. This will be ONLY at 8 AM. The 4 PM Vigil of Sunday does NOT count for this obligation

ETIQUETTE - We cannot help but notice that we seem to have forgotten that old adage of "Our Sunday Best." While decency and cleanliness are primordial, we should also come to Sunday Mass wearing the best we have in honor of Our Lord, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, and the Community. We hope you take note of it. This is not a beach, nor a picnic, nor a discount store... It is the Holy Temple of God, where our Salvation is worked out. We truly appreciate your cooperation in all this.

In Charity there is everything

What is faith but the carriage that bears us to our native land? What is hope but the food we take for our journey through life's hardships?
