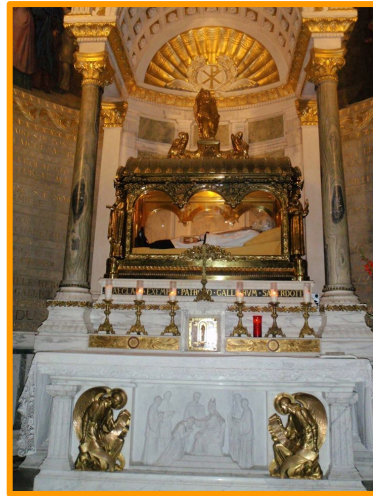
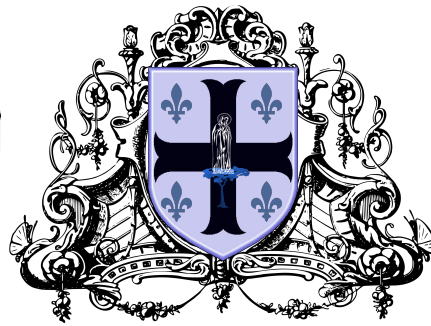


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY**

**EIGHTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST - AUGUST 4, 2019 - EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY O.T.**

**COLLECTION** - We thank those Parishioners who support our Parish with their treasure, talent and time. PLEASE BE GENEROUS! Pray for our Benefactors!

**PLENARY INDULGENCE** - Do not forget to come and get your Plenary Indulgence on the First Saturday of each month as well as the 13th, Fatima Day, of every month.

**CSA** - Many thanks to all who have donated so far. We have superseded our goal in pledges, AND in actually paid funds. Thus, every dollar over our goal comes back to us. If you have not yet pledged or donated or are a new Parishioner, please donate as soon as possible!

**DAILY MASS** - Too many are not taking advantage of this grace and privilege. There are some Catholics who cannot attend daily Mass because of the lack of Priests. Take advantage of the graces conferred by God here in our own Shrine!

**VEILS** - For those ladies who wear or want to wear veils and mantillas in the holy Temple of God, please consider getting one of parishioner Nellie Narciso's creations which are found in the back of the Church. She donates all proceeds to the Ladies' Sodality. Thank you, Nellie!

**PROPER ATTIRE** - We remind everyone of the sanctity of this Temple of God. Proper attire must be worn here at all times, Shorts, picnic wear or any beachwear is NOT acceptable. Mini skirts or sleeveless garments are not either. ALL are asked to respect this holy place! Thank-you!

**HOSPITALS** - If you or any member of your family goes into a hospital or rehab please notify Rev. Canon. If you are ill or in need of Anointing (and Confession which helps the Anointing so much more) please make an appointment with him. Do not take any chance with your immortal soul!

**CONFESSION BOOK** - Rev. Canon's new book on Confession is ready and is available in the back of the Church already... A donation of \$8 is asked.

**CONFESSION** - Even though the Easter season is over, it is not time to abandon the practice of frequent Confession of our sins. Each should try to go at least once a month, but more salutary once a week. However, it is not possible for Father to hear Confessions before the High Mass on Sunday. Please come at the appointed times or during the week.

**PARTICIPATION** - All are asked to vocally and physically participate in the Sacred Mysteries. We need to hear you. While private prayer is of the utmost importance, when we are at community prayer and the Liturgy we should speak loudly and clearly, not whispering to ourselves. It makes a big difference and encourages others to pray and participate. This goes for both the Pauline Rite in English and the Gregorian Rite in latin, as well as the Holy Rosary.

**BURSE CLUB** - Representatives from the St. Stephen Ladies' Sodality will start collecting funds for the education of future Priests for our Diocese. It is \$12 a year but all are encouraged to give more. Thank you for your generosity.

**ABUSE** - The Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee and this Parish are committed to healing the hurting hearts of sexual abuse victims and has established Victim's Assistance Coordinators who are experienced and trained counselors available to help persons who have been sexually abused.
