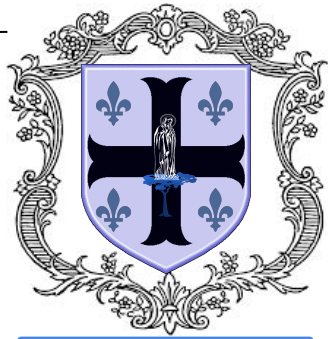


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE
