
WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

HOLY ROSARY - Every day in this Shrine the Holy Rosary is prayed publicly. As we have celebrated Our Lady of Lourdes, remember she prayed the Rosary there with Saint Bernadette and asked us to do so daily.

LENT - There will be Holy Hour and Benediction every Thursday of Lent after the 6 PM Mass. Please try to come and spend some quiet time with Our Lord.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS - We will hold Stations of the Cross and Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament every Friday of Lent in the evening (after the fish fry). This will be at 6 PM.

ST. JOSEPH - Since it falls on a Sunday, the Feast of St. Joseph is moved to the next day, March 20th. However, we will have a covered dish luncheon and prayer in his honor. All are invited to bring food and pictures of deceased loved ones for the St. Joseph Table in the Hall.

CSA - Now that we have begun a new year it is time to be thinking about the CSA for 2023. We remind everyone that it is requirement to participate in this to be considered a bona fide Parishioner. After we meet our goal, wish is \$31K, every cent comes back to us.
