**ASH WEDNESDAY** - This week is Ash Wednesday (March 2nd) when the whole Catholic World begins the ancient celebration of the Penitential Season of Lent, Quadragesima.

**LENTEN DISCIPLINE** - As we begin once again the Solemn and beautiful Season of Lent, the Church's principal penitential season, we remind you that fasting and abstinence are in order. No meat, or its byproducts, should be eaten on Fridays, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and other days of your choice. As much time as possible should be spent at prayer, especially before the Blessed Sacrament. We will have Holy Hour EVERY Thursday of Lent after the 6 PM Low Mass. We will have Benediction and Solemn Stations every Friday at 7 PM. Take advantage of this holy season.

**VOLUNTEERS** - We will need volunteers for the upcoming Fish Frys which begin on the first Friday of Lent, March 4th, and will continue on each Friday, up to the Friday before Palm Sunday. The Ladies' Sodality will also sell desserts. Please support our Shrine and our Holy Name Society.

**TIME CHANGE** - As was mentioned as far back as December, the daily Mass on Mondays and Fridays will change to 8:30 AM beginning with the first full week of March, the 7th.

**THEOLOGY CLASS** - Theology Class will NOT meet on this Wednesday. It will resume in a week on March 9th, in the Parish Hall at approximately 7:10 PM.
