FATIMA PRAYER - ORATIO FATIMAE

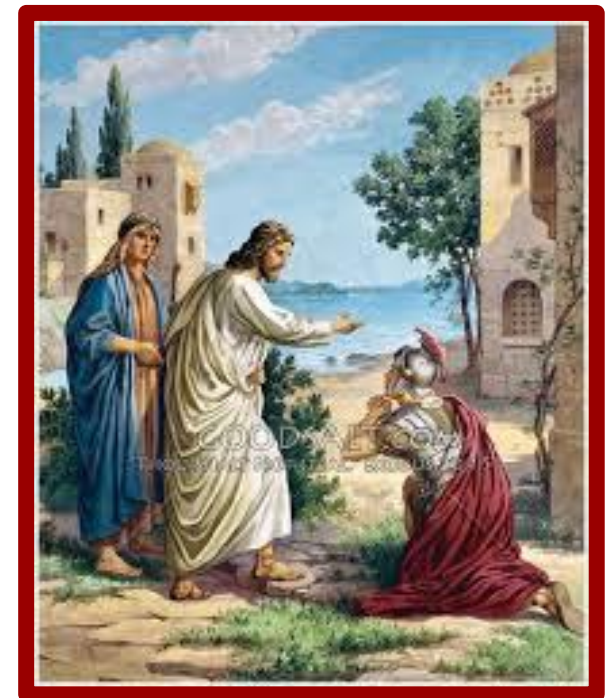
O my Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of Hell. Lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy!

BUILDING FUND - Continuing as we prepare for the actual work in and outside the Church - most of which will start in February after Candlemas. Many thanks to all of you who have donated thus far. May God increase your fortunes as you are generous to Him!

ROSARY - With transfers and people leaving town, we are short of persons who are willing to lead the Rosary before the Sunday High Mass at 10 AM each Sunday. Anyone who might be interested in doing so, please see the Canon.

THEOLOGY CLASS - After so many interruptions and events, we shall continue our Theology Classes THIS Wednesday, January 27th at 7 PM. As we may meet in the Church, please observe the proper attire rules we always observe. All those to be confirmed need to bring their Baptismal certificates as well as the other things mentioned at Class by the Canon.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES - As is our custom here, we will once again have the Sacrament of Anointing (Unction) on the Saturday nearest the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, (Feb. 11th), Feb. 13th after the 4 PM Vigil Mass. One must be chronically, seriously ill or over the age of 65. It is very strongly recommended that you go to Confession BEFORE the Unction. It will work all the better.

CANDLEMAS - This year the Presentation falls on a Tuesday. We will have the Blessing of the Candles, weather permitting, an outdoor candlelight Procession and a High Mass at 6 PM. ALL Acolytes and Schola members are asked to be here. There will be a reception in the Canon Pérez Hall and the 26th Annual Holy Name Society Raffle. It will be a grand old time for all!

RAFFLE - Along with your Offertory envelopes you may find your envelopes for the annual Holy Name Raffle, which will take place on Candlemas Day at night after Mass and during a reception afterwards. ALL Parishioners are asked to participate in buying and selling as many tickets as possible. All the proceeds go to the Holy Name for the Building Funds.

VOLUNTEERS - We will need volunteers for the Candlemas Reception as well as afterwards to cleanup. Also we will need volunteers to help take down the Christmas decorations. There are sign-up lists for each in the back of the Church by the Sacred Heart Shrine.

CSA 21 - Soon we shall receive the information for this New Year's Catholic Sharing Appeal. You donated about \$28,000 last year. Please consider repeating and incrementing your donation for this year. There are many needs that crop up in an old Parish.
