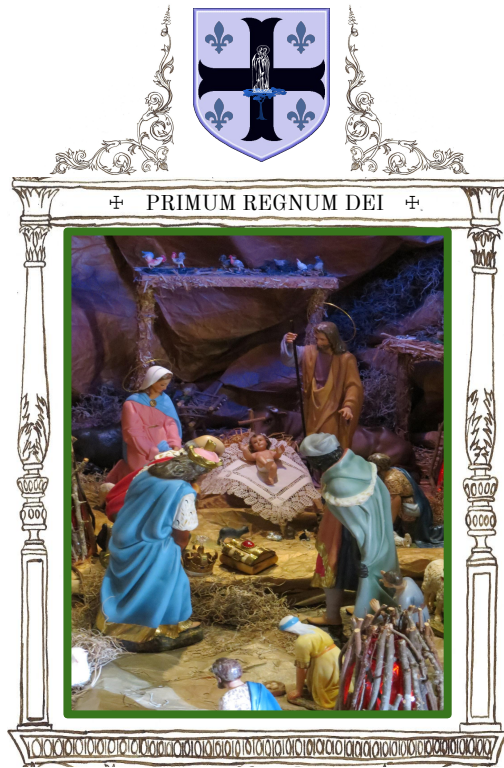


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

Blessed be God in His Angels and in His saints.
