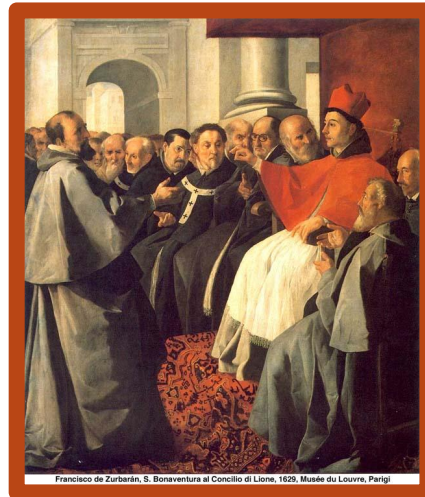
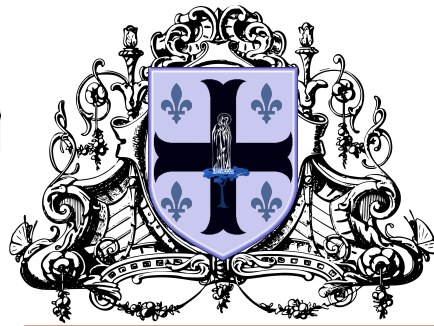


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

PROPER ATTIRE - We remind everyone of the sanctity of this Temple of God. Proper attire must be worn here at all times, Shorts, picnic wear or any beachwear is NOT acceptable. ALL are asked to respect this holy place! Thank-you!

BROWN SCAPULAR - THIS Sunday Rev. Canon will bless and impose the Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel upon those who have not yet been inducted into her Confraternity. Along with the Rosary, the Scapular, is among the most indulgenced Marian devotions in the Church.

CONFESSION BOOK - Rev. Canon's new book on Confession is ready and is available in the back of the Church already... A donation of \$8 is asked.

CHURCH ETIQUETTE - We have been experiencing some problems with the Church bathrooms. Please do not flush anything, like towels, diapers, and the like into the toilets. Also we have noticed many scratches on the pews. Please make sure children do not have keys or hard toys in the pews or in Church. Also we have noticed that some adults throw their keys on the pews. This scratches them... Please take care of our Shrine and its belongings.

HOSPITALS - If you or any member of your family goes into a hospital or rehab please notify Rev. Canon. If you are ill or in need of Anointing (and Confession which helps the Anointing so much more) please make an appointment with him. Do not take any chance with your immortal soul!

CONFESSION - Even though the Easter season is over, it is not time to abandon the practice of frequent Confession of our sins. Each should try to go at least once a month, but more salutary once a week. However, it is not possible for Father to hear Confessions before the High Mass on Sunday. Please come at the appointed times or during the week.

PARTICIPATION - All are asked to vocally and physically participate in the Sacred Mysteries. We need to hear you. While private prayer is of the utmost importance, when we are at community prayer and the Liturgy we should speak loudly and clearly, not whispering to ourselves. It makes a big difference and encourages others to pray and participate. This goes for both the Pauline Rite in English and the Gregorian Rite in latin, as well as the Holy Rosary.

BURSE CLUB - Representatives from the St. Stephen Ladies' Sodality will start collecting funds for the education of future Priests for our Diocese. It is \$12 a year but all are encouraged to give more. Thank you for your generosity.

The BROWN Scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel

Among the many magnificent assurances of salvation in our Holy Catholic Faith is Our Lady's Brown Scapular. One of the great mysteries of our time is that the great majority of Catholics either ignore or have forgotten the Blessed Virgin Mary's promise: "Take this Scapular, it shall be a sign of salvation, a protection in danger and a pledge of peace. Whosoever dies wearing this Scapular shall not suffer eternal fire." She further says: "Wear it devoutly and perseveringly. It is my garment. To be clothed in it means you are continually thinking of me, and I in turn, am always thinking of you and helping you to secure eternal life." During the Scapular Anniversary celebration in Rome, Ven. Pius XII told a very large audience to wear the Brown Scapular as a sign of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady asked for this consecration in the last apparition at Fatima, when she appeared as Our Lady of Mount Carmel, holding the Brown Scapular out to the whole world. It was Her last loving appeal to souls to wear Her Scapular as a sign of Consecration to Her Immaculate Heart... St. Claude de la Colombiere, the renowned Jesuit and spiritual director of St. Margaret Mary, gives a point which is enlightening. He said: "Because all the forms of our love for the Blessed Virgin, all its various modes of expression cannot be equally pleasing to Her, and therefore do not assist us in the same degree to Heaven. I say without a moment's hesitation that the BROWN SCAPULAR IS THE MOST FAVORED OF ALL!" He also adds: "No devotion has been confirmed by more numerous authentic miracles than the Brown Scapular."
