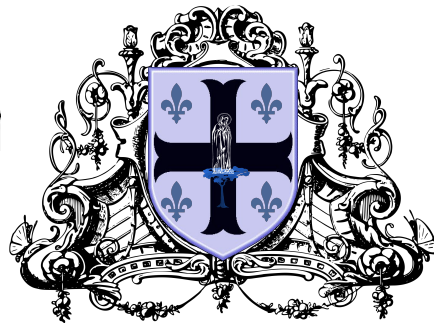


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

Each should try to go at least once a month, but more salutary once a week. However, it is not possible for Father to hear Confessions before the High Mass on Sunday. Please come at the appointed time or during the week by appointment.
