## THE ANGEIUS AND THE SAIVE REGINA

With the "Time throughout the Year" that begins with the Feast of the Most Blessed Trinity, the Marian Antiphons switch once again. The Angelus returns (at 6 or 8 AM; Noon; 6 PM) and the Regina Coeli is put away until Easter next year. The beautiful and ancient "Salve Regina" or "Hail, Holy Queen" also returns. We reproduce them here in Latin and English for your use and edification. Pray these also at home with your family !
