**DISPENSATION - FROM THE BISHOP:** The time has come to end the dispensation and ensure that all baptized Catholics return to the practice - indeed, the obligation - of attending the celebration of the Eucharist (i.e., Mass) every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation. Therefore, the dispensation to attend Mass will end on the afternoon of June 19th. Thus, every Catholic in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee should celebrate Mass in person beginning on June 20, 2021 (or the Vigil on June 19). The obligation to attend Mass is one of the precepts of the Church. It is considered a serious sin to miss Mass if one does not have a good reason to do so.

**FIRST COMMUNION** - We congratulate all those who made their First Communion last Sunday. We also thank all those who worked so hard to make our celebration: High Mass and Luncheon a tremendous success! Next year it will be during our 100th Jubilee Year, in June.

**CSA** - We remind everyone that it is necessary to participate in the CSA. Now that we have reached our goal, all funds that are collected will go to our savings account for our own needs.

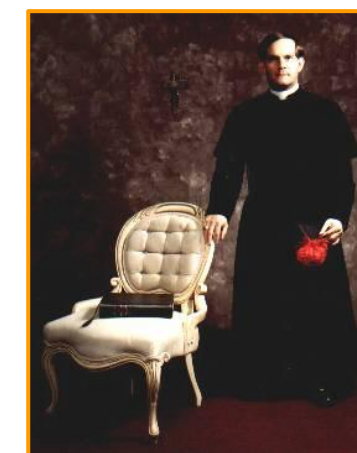
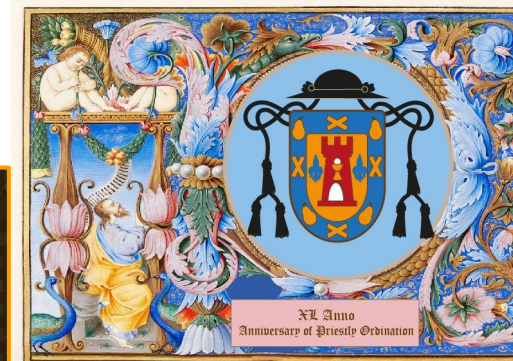
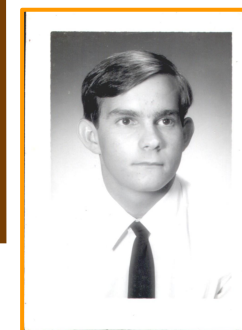
