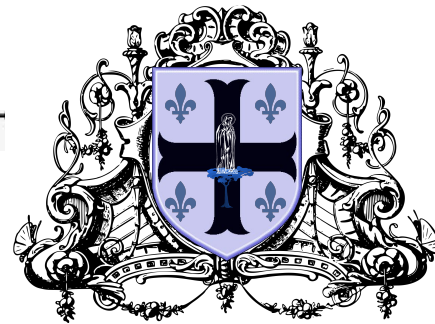


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

THE ANGELUS

With the end of the Paschal Season, we return to the praying of the Angelus Three times a day. Here it is for you in English and Latin.

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.
R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.
Hail, Mary...
V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
R. Be it done unto me according to thy word.
Hail Mary....
V. And the Word was made flesh.
R. And dwelt among us.
Hail Mary...
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray;
V. Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.
V. May the Divine Assistance remain with us always.

***R.** And with all our absent brothers, and may the souls of the Faithful Departed through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

OUR LADY'S ANTIPHON

(From the Regina Coeli used at Paschal Time we now start the Antiphon used during most of the year after Trinity Sunday. Particularly used at the end of Compline at night before retiring for the day).

Salve, Regina, Mater misericordiae; vita, dulcedo et spes nostra, salve. Ad te clamamus exsules filii Evae. Ad te suspiramus gementes et flentes in hac lacrimarum valle. Eia ergo, advocata nostra, illos tuos misericordes oculos ad nos converte. Et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui, nobis post hoc exsilium ostende.

O clemens, o pia, o dulcis Virgo Maria.
