Canon will continue to hear Confessions in the Sacristy after the Saturday morning Mass and the Saturday evening Mass. He is available on other days, but not at night... There will be NO Confessions during the Easter Triduum, except in danger of death. Please note. Prepare ahead!

VOLUNTEERS - We will need volunteers for the upcoming Fish Frys which begin on the first Friday of Lent, Feb. 19th, and will continue on each Friday up to the Friday before Palm Sunday. The Ladies Sodality will also sell desserts.

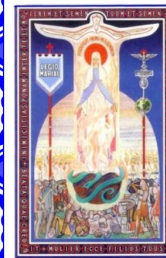


2021 Catholic Sharing Appeal
