


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

THE MYSTERY OF HOLY WEEK

"We have entered into Holy Week. Over the next few days, led by the Church's Liturgy, we will relive the Mysteries of our Salvation. The Easter Triduum is the summit of the liturgical year. In it we recall, with deep and grateful hearts, that by dying Christ destroyed our death and by rising He restored our life. Let us prepare ourselves to live these celebrations with intensity, in the clear realization that, if we share now in the sufferings of Christ, we will one day rejoice and exult in the revelation of His glory." (St. John Paul II)

PALM SUNDAY - Our Lord enters triumphantly into Jerusalem, as King, with "Hosannas to the Son of David".

HOLY MONDAY - In ancient times the whole Sanctuary of the churches was veiled to show that Jesus hid Himself henceforth. Jesus went to Bethany with his friends, St. Lazarus and sisters, and the Blessed Mother as well.

HOLY TUESDAY - Judas Iscariot plots against Jesus with the Pharisees, Sanhedrin and the High Priest.

HOLY WEDNESDAY - Judas betrays Our Lord for thirty pieces of silver. Also called Spy Wednesday.

SACRED TRIDUUM - Salvation is wrought by Him for us! Deo gratias! On Holy Thursday the Priesthood and the Eucharist. On Good Friday the Great Sacrifice of our Salvation. On Holy Saturday He descends into the Limbo of the Fathers and visits the Just of the Old Testament.
