**QUINQUAGESIMA - MARCH 3, 2019 - 8TH SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY**

**ASH WEDNESDAY** - March 6th is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. Though it is not a holy day of obligation, it IS a holy day of love. Masses for Ash Wednesday will be in English at 8 AM. The Ashes will be blessed and imposed on all there after the Homily. There will also be a High Mass in the Gregorian Rite at 6 PM. In this Rite the Ashes are blessed and imposed BEFORE the Mass, though it would be disrespectful and inappropriate to get the Ashes and then leave... The Holy Rosary will be recited after the 8 AM Mass and at 5:30 PM before the evening Mass.

**THEOLOGY CLASS** - The Theology class which has resumed on Wed., at 7 PM in the Hall will NOT meet on this coming, Ash Wednesday. We will study Pope Pius XI's "Casti Connubi" on Catholic Marriage. One cannot emphasize enough how important these Church Magisterial documents are to those who are married or planning to be married!

**ROSARY** - Once again Father will make a lovely and fine Rosary for the Ladies' Sodality to raffle. The tickets are \$3 apiece. It will be worth between \$200-300. Father will bless it and also use it to pray for whomever the winner may be.

**CONFESSION** - Rev. Canon's new book on Confession is ready. Will be on sale in the back of the Church soon. Which leads us to the fact that ALL are encouraged to make their "Easter Duty" Confessions according to the Law of the Church. The time is from Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday.

**FISH FRIES** - With Lent begin our three Holy Name Society Lenten Fish Fries which will take place on Fridays; March 8th; March 23rd, and April 5th. The price for the dinner is \$8 this year. Drinks are free. Desserts are sold by the Ladies' Sodality. Everyone is asked to volunteer and to come partake of this great opportunity to build up the Shrine/Parish Family! Karaoke, too!

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** - We will have the Solemn celebration of the Stations followed by Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist on every Friday in Lent beginning with this coming Friday.
