THEOLOGY CLASS - We will have class on this Wednesday, March 10th, as soon as possible after the Low Mass at 6 PM, in the Canon Pérez Hall.

JOSEPH FEAST - Since St. Joseph's Solemnity is a Friday - and we have many things on that day - we have decided to have a St. Joseph covered-dish luncheon on Sunday, March 21st, after the High Mass. That way, as many as possible can stay for the Legion of Mary Acies. Please plan to attend this! All are encouraged to bring pictures of family members, alive or deceased, to put under the Protection of this Great Saint. He is also the protector of a holy death.

ACIES - We invite and encourage ALL our Parishioners (certainly Schola and Acolytes) and all Active and Auxiliary Legionaries to the Annual Acies, Sunday, March 21st at 4 PM. This will be the 45th year! This is very important to our Shrine and its Rector.

ST. BENEDICT - The Canon will bless all St. Benedict medals on his Feast on March 21st. Please bring the items identified, in a ziplock bag or box. The next time he will do this is on his other Feast, July 11th.

CONFESSION - All are reminded to make every effort to confess your sins during Lent. The Easter Duty Confession begins on Ash Wednesday until Trinity Sunday (May 30th this year). Rev. Canon will continue to hear Confessions in the Sacristy after the Saturday morning Mass and the Saturday evening Mass. He is available on other days, but not at night...

THANKS - We thank all of you who have been helping to clean up the Church before Mass each evening. Though the workers are doing an outstanding job of cleaning up, there is still dust, etc. which lingers. A major cleaning will have to take place once it is all done. It will be well worthwhile...

VOLUNTEERS - We will need volunteers for the upcoming Fish Frys which begin on the first Friday of Lent, Feb. 19th, and will continue on each Friday up to the Friday before Palm Sunday. The Ladies Sodality will also sell desserts.

CSA 2021 - We began last weekend to hand out and take your pledges and donations. You donated about \$28,000 last year. Please consider repeating and incrementing your donation for this year. 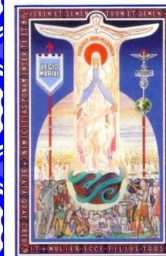


2021 Catholic Sharing Appeal
