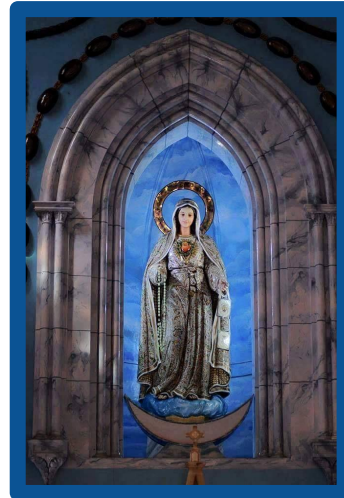
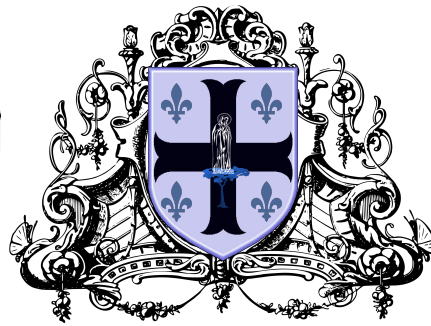


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

THIRD SUNDAY AFTER EASTER - MAY 12, 2019 - FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

EASTER DUTY - Have you made YOUR Easter Duty yet? Time is running out. One needs to go to Confession (and Holy Communion) before Trinity Sunday, which is June 16th.

MOTHERS' DAY - Even though TODAY is Mothers' Day, we will still be accepting more names, due to the brevity of time this year between Easter and now. Rev. Canon will include all the names you submit (even late) in his Mass intentions. Please make sure the names you wish remembered are printed or typed clearly. Make checks to Father. He will remember your Mothers' for a month after every day.

THEOLOGY CLASS - The Theology class has resumed on May 8th at 7 PM in the Hall, we will not meet on this coming Wed. The course will end for this year at the end of May. There may be some extra classes during the summer as required by the Parishioners.

PLENARY INDULGENCE - Do not forget to come and get your Plenary Indulgence on the First Saturday of each month as well as the 13th, Fatima Day, of every month.

ROSARY - The Rosary made by Rev. Canon for the Ladies' Sodality will be raffled THIS SUNDAY after the High Mass at 10:30 AM. You still have a chance to win, by purchasing tickets from one of the representatives of the Sodality.

CONFESSION BOOK - Rev. Canon's new book on Confession is ready and is available in the back of the Church already... A donation of \$8 is asked.

MOTHERS' DAY - To honor all our Mothers and especially the holy Mother of God, we ask that the Ladies and Girls of the Shrine bring up flowers at the Procession at the beginning of Mass at the High Mass at 10:30 AM next Sunday. We ask that they wear white or blue dresses and veils. The flowers will be provided in the Foyer for all the Ladies.

FIRST COMMUNION - The First Communion this year will take place on the External Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Sunday June 30th, because of schedule conflicts. The Message of Fatima Revisited

First apparition of Our Lady of Fatima: May 13, 1917

Sister Lucia's Memoirs (From the book "Fatima in Lucia's own words"):

Your Excellency,

In obedience to the order which Your Excellency gave me in your letter of July 26th, 1941, that I should think over and note down anything else I could remember about Jacinta, I have given thought to the matter and decided that, as God was speaking to me through you, the moment has arrived to reply to two questions which have often been sent to me, but which I have put off answering until now.

What is the Secret? It seems to me that I can reveal it, since I already have permission from heaven to do so. God's representatives on earth have authorized me to do this several times and in various letters, one of which, I believe, is in your keeping. This advises me to write to the Holy Father, suggesting, among other things, that I should reveal the secret. . .

Well, the secret is made up of three distinct parts, two of which I am now going to reveal. The first part is the vision of Hell. Our Lady showed us a great sea of fire which seemed to be under the earth. Plunged in this fire were demons and souls in human form, like transparent burning embers, all blackened or burnished bronze, floating about in the conflagration, now raised into the air by the flames that issued from within themselves together with great clouds of smoke, now falling back on every side like sparks in a huge fire, without weight or equilibrium, and amid shrieks and groans of pain and despair, which horrified us and made us tremble with fear. The demons could be distinguished by their terrifying and repellent likeness to frightful and unknown animals, all black and transparent.

This vision lasted but an instant. How can we ever be grateful enough to our kind heavenly Mother, who had already prepared us by promising, in the first Apparition, to take us to heaven. Otherwise, I think we would have died of fear and terror. We then looked up at Our Lady, who said to us so kindly and so sadly:

"You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace. The war is going to end: but if people do not cease offending God, a worse one will break out during the pontificate of Pius XI. When you see a night illumined by an unknown light, know that this is the great sign given you by God that He is about to punish the world for its crimes, by means of war, famine, and persecutions of the Church and of the Holy Father. "To prevent this, I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the Communion of reparation on the First Saturdays. If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted, and there will be peace; if not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The good will be martyred; the Holy Father will have much to suffer; various nations will be annihilated. In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me, and she will be converted, and a period of peace will be granted to the world. (To be continued).
