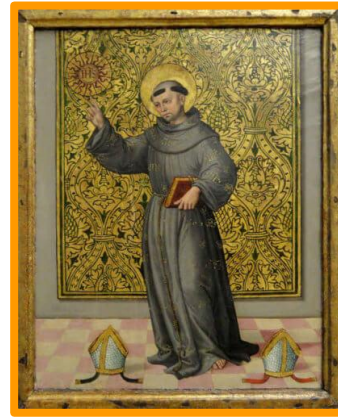
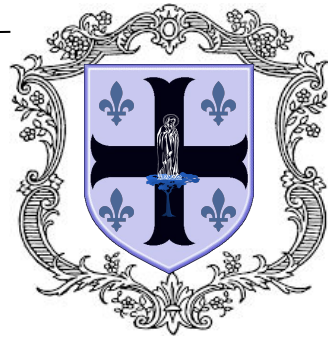


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE

FATHERS' DAY - The envelopes for requesting for Fathers to be included in the Masses offered from Fathers' Day for a month are stapled to this bulletin and in the Foyer. Make sure you get them to us ASAP. Print all your names clearly. The names of all handed in to Rev. Canon will be remembered by him at the Altar.

JUNE 14TH - This day we will have our First Holy Communions for those children who have been preparing. It is also Rev. Canon's Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood. Other than the High Mass, we hope to have at least a small reception if not a full fledged covered dish by then.

OPENING - At long last the Church and the Sacred liturgy of the Mass will be OPEN to all. This began on Wednesday, May 6. We remind you that we will have Mass at 6 PM on Thursday followed by Benediction and the Novena to the Infant of Prague. For more information on the "opening" please refer to the Diocesan website. If anyone is sick please DO NOT come to the Church or for Mass. We cannot spread any illness to anyone else, especially the elderly and Rev. Canon.

HOLY NAME SOCIETY - The Men will have their next meeting on the last Sunday in May, the 31st, in the Canon Pérez Hall. No need to fear there is much room...

ASCENSION THURSDAY - We will celebrate the ascension of the Lord on Thursday, May 21st. High Mass at 6 PM followed by Benediction. For Traditional Catholics it is a holy day of obligation. The Rosary will be at 5:30, as usual for evening Mass days.

NOVENA - The Traditional Novena to the Holy Spirit begins the day after Ascension Thursday. It is here attached to your bulletins (take it home and also bring it back for your own personal use in the Church for safety precautions no more will be provided). This is the most important Novena, commanded by Our Lord Himself! If you cannot be here every day then please say it at home - perhaps before or after the Family Rosary.

CSA - If you have not yet made your pledge to our Campaign, please do so. Once we meet our goal, we will get everything back for our own needs here. Please help us to do so and better even! We have almost reached our goal!

THANKS - The Rev. Canon wishes to thank all those Parishioners and Friends of St. Stephen who have been generously mailing their offertory tithes or donating them online, We need to make every effort to keep our wonderful Shrine and Parish open and in working order. As soon as all of this is over we will continue with our plans for a new ceiling and all the other Projects. In the meantime the Canon is praying for each of you every day at Mass and at adoration.
