MASSES - Beginning with the first week of May we will try a new Mass schedule. Masses will continue at 6 PM on TUESDAYS, WEDNESDAYS AND THURSDAYS. We will go back to the 8 AM slot on MONDAYS AND FRIDAYS. Any other changes will be announced before it happens.

MAY 13 - Since it falls on a Thursday, we shall include our Rosary and Low Mass and Benediction in this year's program for honoring Our Lady. Please be here! It also happens to be Ascension Thursday, a holy day of obligation for us Traditionalist Catholics. Of course, it is a Plenary Indulgence day!

FIRST FRIDAY - This coming Friday will be the first of the month of May. As usual we will have Low Mass on Thursday evening followed by Holy Hour and Benediction as we make Reparation. pray for our Shrine and parish and pray for holy vocations to the Priesthood and Religious life. It is important that all of us partake of these blessings available to us here.

SAVE THE DATE - Rev. Canon will be celebrating the 40th Anniversary of his Ordination in June. We will celebrate as a Parish on Sunday, June 13th at the High Mass. There will be a reception in the Canon Pérez Hall afterwards.
