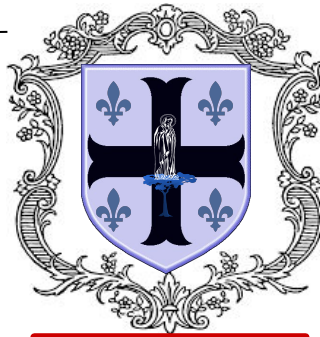


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE

SUNDAY AFTER THE ASCENSION - MAY 24, 2020 - SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

FATHERS' DAY - The envelopes for requesting for Fathers to be included in the Masses offered from Fathers' Day for a month are in the Foyer. Make sure you get them to us ASAP. Print all your names clearly. The names of all handed in to Rev. Canon will be remembered by him at the Altar.

JUNE 14TH - This day we will have our First Holy Communion for those children who have been preparing. It is also Rev. Canon's Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood. Other than the High Mass, we hope to have at least a small reception if not a full fledged covered dish by then.

OPENING - At long last the Church and the Sacred liturgy of the Mass will be OPEN to all. This began on Wednesday, May 6. We remind you that we will have Mass at 6 PM on Thursday followed by Benediction and the Novena to the Infant of Prague. For more information on the "opening" please refer to the Diocesan website. If anyone is sick please DO NOT come to the Church or for Mass. We cannot spread any illness to anyone else, especially the elderly and Rev. Canon.

SPECIAL CLASS - Rev. Canon will host a special class in Latin pronunciation to assist all with the Liturgy on this coming Wednesday at 7 PM in the Parish Hall. Please be here.

NOVENA - The Traditional Novena to the Holy Spirit began the day after Ascension Thursday. It is here attached to your bulletins (take it home and also bring it back for your own personal use in the Church for safety precautions no more will be provided). This is the most important Novena, commanded by Our Lord Himself! If you cannot be here every day then please say it at home - perhaps before or after the Family Rosary.
