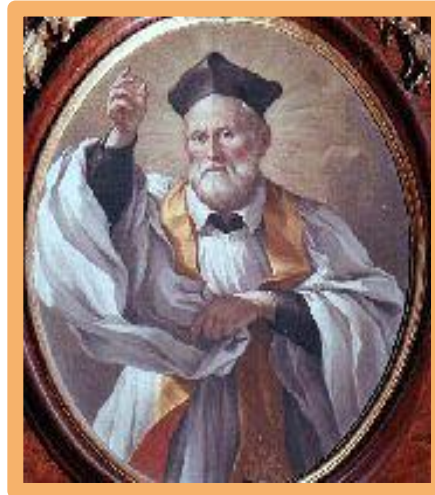
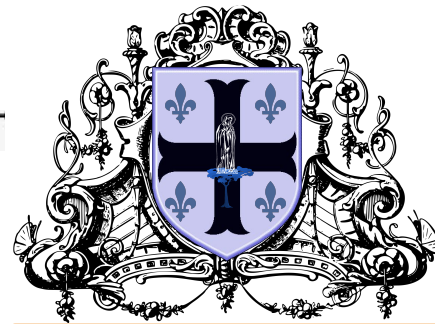


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY**

**FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER - MAY 26, 2019 - SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER**

**EASTER DUTY** - Have you made YOUR Easter Duty yet? Time is running out. One needs to go to Confession (and Holy Communion) before Trinity Sunday, which is June 16th.

**FATHERS' DAY** - Even Not too early to think of all our fathers whom we wish to be remembered on Fathers' Day and for a month thereafter on the Altar. You may find the envelopes for requests in the Foyer. Do the same as for Mothers' Day.

**PLENARY INDULGENCE** - Do not forget to come and get your Plenary Indulgence on the First Saturday of each month as well as the 13th, Fatima Day, of every month.

**LEGION OF MARY** - Has anyone invited you to join the Legion? First as an auxiliary member praying the Rosary each day with millions of Catholics throughout the world, Then, if Father approves, as an Active member going to the weekly meeting and visiting the sick, shut-ins, and other works. Our Legion Praesidium of Our Lady of Victory, literally visits and contacts thousands each year. Be part of this great work!

**CSA** - Many thanks to all who have donated so far. We have superseded our goal in pledges, though not in actually paid funds. Every dollar over our goal comes back to us. Please donate and be generous! We need this!

**HOSPITALS** - Nowadays hospitals and other healthcare facilities do not notify the parish or the Priest. If you are planning a surgery let Father know so you can make a proper Confession and receive the Anointing of the Sick. If there is an emergency equally call the Shrine and leave a message if no one is present.

**NOVENA** - The Solemn Novena to the Holy Spirit begins Friday after the Ascension and continues until the Eve of Pentecost. Copies are included in THIS bulletin and may be found in the Foyer as well and throughout the pews for the faithful to use at all Masses. This is the most important novena of all, commanded by Christ Himself. Please pray it for the Church in these tormentous times!

**CONFESSION BOOK** - Rev. Canon's new book on Confession is ready and is available in the back of the Church already... A donation of \$8 is asked.

**THE ASCENSION** - We remind everyone that the traditional date of the Feast of Ascension Thursday is, Thursday, May 30th - for Traditionalists a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be a Mass at 6 PM that evening followed by Benediction. All are requested to be present.

**FIRST COMMUNION** - The First Communion this year will take place on the External Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Sunday, June 30th, because of schedule conflicts. Parents, so children will be ready to receive this Most Blessed Sacrament, talk to Father and get the requirements from him. You must be a registered and tithing Parishioner.

**CHURCH ETIQUETTE** - We have been experiencing some problems with the Church bathrooms. Please do not flush anything, like towels, diapers, and the like into the toilets. Also we have noticed many scratches on the pews. Please make sure children do not have keys or hard toys in the pews or in Church.

**LAWN MAINTENANCE** - There is a sign-up list in the Foyer for those able-bodied men who can volunteer to mow the lawn, etc. This is done every two weeks by you volunteers. **The Message of Fatima Revisited**

**THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY**

The second part refers to the devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

As I have already written in the second account, Our Lady told me on June 13th, 1917, that she would never forsake me, and that her Immaculate Heart would be my refuge and the way that would lead me to God. As she spoke these words, she opened her hands, and from them streamed a light that penetrated to our inmost hearts. I think that, on that day, the main purpose of this light was to infuse within us a special knowledge and love for the Immaculate Heart of Mary, just as on the other two occasions it was intended to do, as it seems to me, with regard to God and the mystery of the most Holy Trinity. From that day onwards, our hearts were filled with a more ardent love for the Immaculate Heart of Mary. From time to time, Jacinta said to me: "The Lady said that her Immaculate heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God. Don't you love that? Her Heart is so good! How I love It!"

As I explained earlier, Our Lady told us, in the July secret, that God wished to establish in the world devotion to her Immaculate Heart; and that to prevent a future war, she would come to ask for the consecration of Russia to her Immaculate Heart, and for the Communion of Reparation of the First Saturdays. From then on, whenever we spoke of this among ourselves, Jacinta said: "I am so grieved to be unable to receive Communion in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary!"

I have also mentioned already how Jacinta chose from the litany of ejaculations which Father Cruz suggested to us, this one: "Sweet Heart of Mary, be my salvation!" After saying it, she used to add sometimes, with the simplicity that was natural to her: "I so love the Immaculate Heart of Mary! It is the heart of our dear Mother in heaven! Don't you love saying many times over: 'Sweet heart of Mary, Immaculate Heart of Mary'? I love it so much, so very much."
