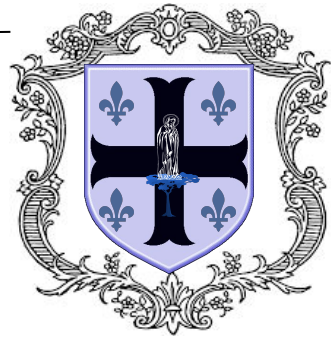


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE

**MOTHERS' DAY** - The envelopes for requesting for Mothers to be included in the Masses offered from Mothers' Day for a month are stapled to this bulletin and in the Foyer. Make sure you get them to us ASAP. Print all your names clearly. The names of all handed in to Rev. Canon will be remembered by him at the Altar. (Even those who are late, this year, please bring them anyway!).

**MAY 13TH** - We will have a special celebration of the 103rd Anniversary of the First Apparition of Our Lady of Fatima on Wednesday, May 13th. We will have a High Mass at 6 PM. Holy Rosary will be at 5:30 PM as on Thursdays and we will have the Novena of Our Lady of Fatima and consecration to her Immaculate Heart and Benediction after the Mass. ALL are encouraged to come! (There will be NO Mass that day at 8 AM).

**OPENING** - At long last the Church and the Sacred liturgy of the Mass will be OPEN to all. This begins on Wednesday, May 6. We remind you that we will have Mass at 6 PM on Thursday followed by Benediction and the Novena to the Infant of Prague. For more information on the "opening" please refer to the Diocesan website. If anyone is sick please DO NOT come to the Church or for Mass. We cannot spread any illness to anyone else, especially the elderly and Rev. Canon.

**MAY** - The month of May is dedicated in a special way to the Blessed Mother. That is why we have Mothers' Day in May. She is the patroness and Model of Womanhood, authentic Femininity and Motherhood. ALL are encouraged to pray the Holy Rosary each day and commend themselves and this our beloved Shrine to Our Lady, may she protect us from all evil!
