V. Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord.

## **OUR LADY'S ANTIPHON**

(From the Regina Coeli used at Paschal Time we now start the Antiphon used during most of the year after Trinity Sunday. Particularly used at the end of Compline at night before retiring for the day.)

Eia ergo, advocata nostra, illos tuos misericordes oculos ad nos converte. Et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui, nobis post hoc exsilium ostende.
