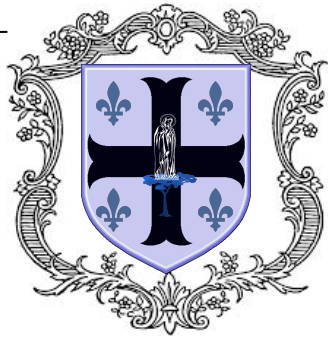


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE

FATHERS' DAY - The envelopes for requesting for Fathers to be included in the Masses offered from Fathers' Day for a month are in the Foyer. Make sure you get them to us ASAP. Print all your names clearly. The names of all handed in to Rev. Canon will be remembered by him at the Altar.

JUNE 14TH - This day we will have our First Holy Communion for those children who have been preparing. It is also Rev. Canon's Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood. Other than the High Mass, we hope to have at least a small reception if not a full fledged covered dish by then.

OPENING - At long last the Church and the Sacred liturgy of the Mass will be OPEN to all! Confessions will be heard only on Saturdays at 3PM until 3:30 when the Rosary starts, in the Sacristy. Also on weekdays after the 8 AM Mass and Rosary. Not on Sundays...

HOLY NAME SOCIETY - The Men will have their next meeting on THIS Sunday, May 31st, in the Canon Pérez Hall. No need to fear there is much room...

ETIQUETTE - Now that warm weather has arrived, it is important to note that ALL are expected to observe proper etiquette when entering and remaining in the holy House of God, our Shrine and Temple of God and Our Lady. No indecent fashions are permitted. Likewise no shorts beach or picnic wear is permitted AT ANY TIME, much less for Holy Mass. We should always strive to wear the very best, especially for Sunday Mass. Cooperation is expected and appreciated from ALL!

FIRST COMMUNION - All parents of those children who need to make their First Confession and First Holy Communion (tentatively on Sunday, June 14th) need to be in touch with the Rev. Canon. You also need to supply him with a copy of your child's Baptismal certificate.

FIRST FRIDAY - This coming week we have both the First Friday and First Saturday of the month of June, dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will have Holy Hour of Reparation and Prayer for our Shrine and for Vocations this coming Thursday after the usual 6 PM Low Mass. Everyone is encouraged to attend.

FIRST SATURDAY - We will hold the usual Low Mass and Novena to Our lady of Fatima Saturday at 8 AM followed by Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. We will also have an Acolyte practice for ALL acolytes and those boys and men who wish to learn how to serve the Mass.

LADIES' SODALITY - The Ladies will have their next meeting after the First Saturday Devotions in the Canon Pérez Hall.

PLENARY INDULGENCE - We remind all that First Saturday, as well as the 13th of every month is a Plenary Indulgence Day here at our Shrine, following the usual prescriptions of the Law. Confessions will be heard after the Acolyte practice and Ladies' Sodality on First Saturday.



THE ANGELUS AND THE SALVE REGINA

With the "Time throughout the Year" that begins with the Feast of the Most Blessed Trinity, the marian Antiphons switch once again. The Angelus returns (at 6 or 8 AM; Noon; 6 PM) and the Regina Coeli is put away until Easter next year. The beautiful and ancient "Salve Regina" or "Hail, Holy Queen" also returns. We reproduce them here in Latin and English for your use and edification. Pray these also at home with your family!

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.
R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail, Mary...
V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
R. Be it done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary....
V. And the Word was made flesh.
R. And dwelt among us. Hail Mary....
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray; **V.** Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.

V. May the Divine Assistance remain with us always.

***R.** And with all our absent brothers, and may the souls of the Faithful Departed through the mercy of God rest in peace. Amen.
