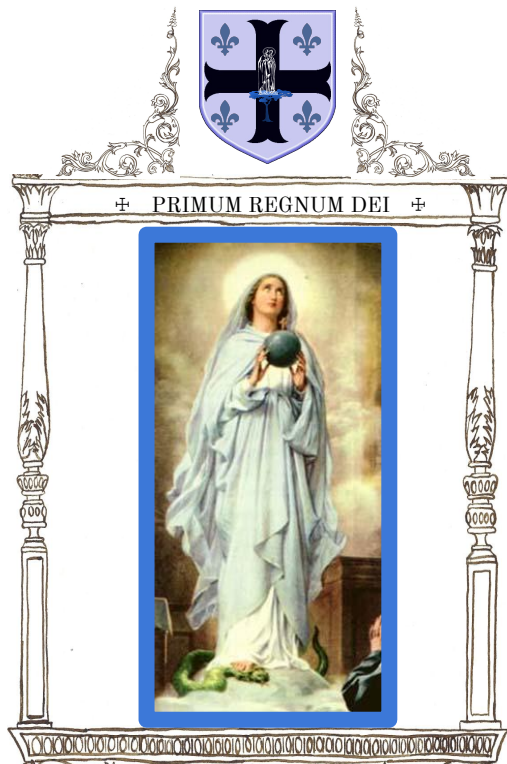


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY
