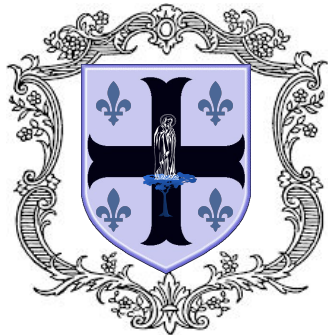


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE

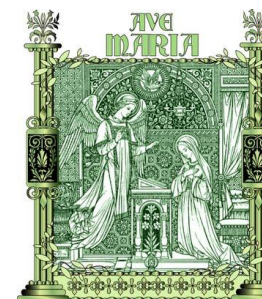


*With the First vespers of Advent we begin a new Liturgical Season and Year of Grace, this includes the beautiful Advent and Christmas Marian Antiphon commemorating the Incarnation of the Word of God in Mary's Immaculate Womb. The Church uses this in the Divine Office at the end of Compline each day. Since it is a part of our Catholic heritage and Tradition we include it here for your convenience and edification. All should learn to pray and chant this.*
