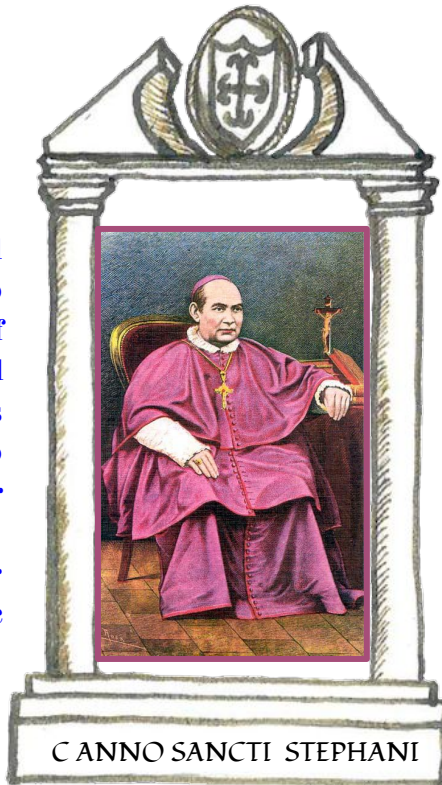


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

DAY OF RECOLLECTION - On the First Saturday, November 5th, the Pensacola Comitium is sponsoring a Day of Recollection for ALL Legionaries, Active and Auxiliary. All others are welcome as well. It will commence with Holy Mass at 8 AM, Novena to Our Lady of Fatima, and Benediction. Canon Pérez will preach during the all day exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. There will be Benediction, again, at 3 PM. There will be a covered-dish luncheon at 12 Noon in the Hall.
