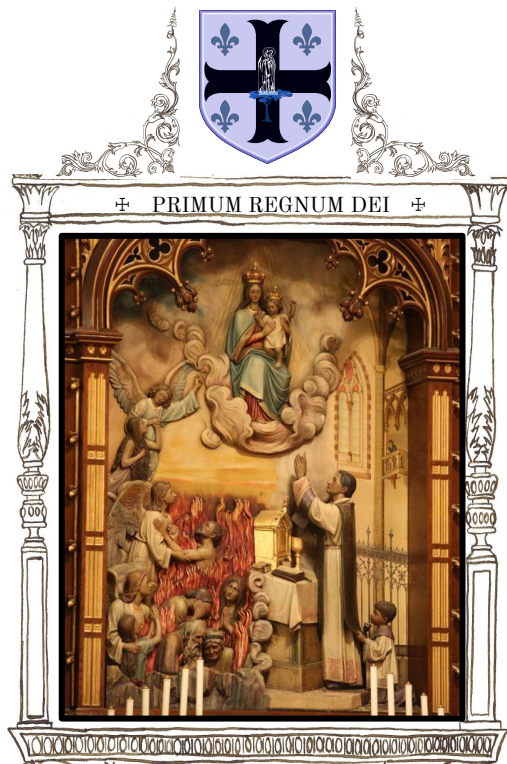


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

SOLEMN FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING - OCTOBER 31, 2021 - 31st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THEOLOGY CLASS - Got off to a good start. There will be no class this coming Wednesday because of Holy Hour Thursday. There will be class on the next two weeks.

HOLYDAY OF OBLIGATION - We remind everyone that Nov. 1, All Saints' Day, is a Holyday of Obligation. All Catholics are required, under the pain of mortal sin, to assist at Holy Mass. We will have a High Mass here at 6 PM. All Souls' Day follows and is one of Obligation of Love - for the Suffering Souls in Purgatory. ALL are highly encouraged to be here for Mass.

CONDOLENCES - Our deep sorrow to Parishioner Cristian Bosio and his Family on the death this week of his mother, Aida Ester Bosio. May she rest in peace.

FIRST FRIDAY - This coming is First Friday and Saturday with the Legion of Mary Congress in addition on First Saturday. All Acolytes are requested to be here. The Ladies' Sodality meeting is transferred to Nov. 13th.

HOLY NAME SOCIETY - The monthly meeting for October is transferred to NEXT Sunday. All men are invited.

ALL SOULS' DAY - As is Ancient Tradition, Rev. Canon will celebrate three Holy Masses on All Souls' Day. They will be at 8 AM and 9 AM - both Low Masses; and a High Requiem Mass at 6 PM. ALL are encouraged to attend as many as possible. It is the present Discipline that the Faithful may receive at two Masses. During the whole week, and month, there are many Plenary and other indulgences that may be gained for the Holy Souls by visiting the tombs of the dead and praying for those in Purgatory.

LEGION OF MARY - The Rev. Canon has decided that since it is once again not possible to hold the weekend retreat at Sacred Heart Monastery in November, he will hold a Day of Recollection - or Congress - on Saturday, November 6th. It will begin with Low Mass, Novena and Benediction. Since it is First Saturday, it is a Day of Plenary Indulgence. The Blessed Sacrament will remain exposed until before the Vigil Mass. EVERYONE, not just Legionaries, is invited and encouraged to attend. The Ladies' Sodality meeting is postponed until November 13th. Brunch will be had in the Hall and Confessions available. This is a GREAT OPPORTUNITY FOR OUR PARISH AND SHRINE!
