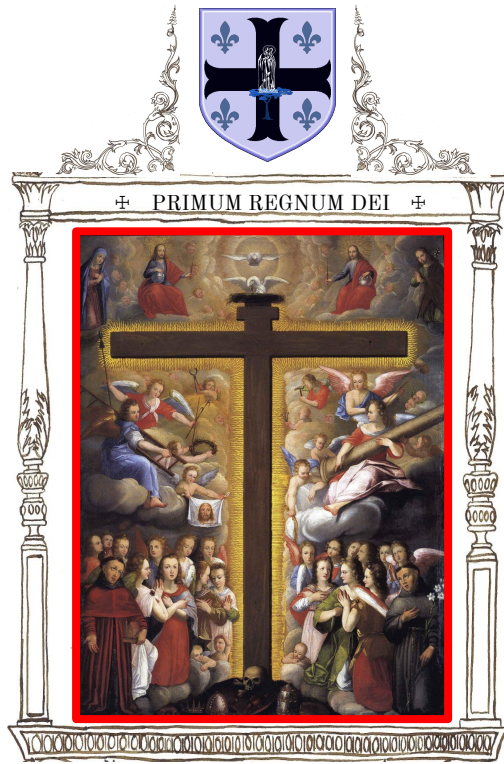


## WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

**ROSARY RALLY** - As usual our Shrine will hold, along with the sponsorship of the Legion of Mary, a Rosary Rally on the Saturday nearest the Feast Of Our Lady of Fatima. This will be held in conjunction with the Low Mass of Saturday, October 16th. Weather permitting we will process from the Hall into the Church with Our Lady's statue (4 men volunteers are needed), the Mass and then the Fifteen Mysteries of the Rosary - as Our Lady gave them to St. Dominic and as she showed the Shepherds of Fatima. Also her Novena will be recited ending with Benediction. There will be a reception in the Hall afterwards.
