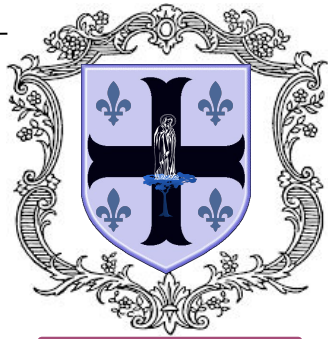


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

4. The Meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross.
5. The Crucifixion.
6. The Deposition of Jesus from the Cross.
7. The Burial of Jesus.
