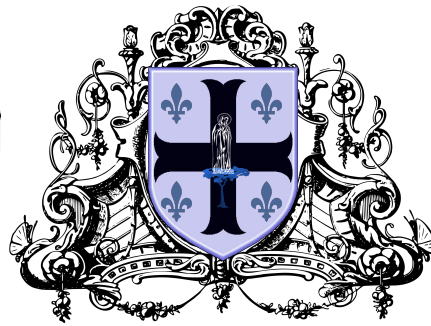


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

ANNUAL ROSARY RALLY - This year the Rally returns to Our Lady's Shrine, where it all began years ago. Please EVERYONE, make every effort to be here as we honor Our Lady of Fatima and celebrate this 102nd Anniversary of her last Apparition at Fatima and the great Miracle of the Sun! The rally will be at 10 AM with a Rosary Procession and Benediction. A reception will follow in the Hall.

Remember, it is NOT necessary to go to Confession every time one goes to Communion. All should strive to confess at least monthly.

HOSPITALS - If you or any member of your family goes into a hospital or rehab please notify Rev. Canon. If you are ill or in need of Anointing (and Confession which helps the Anointing so much more) please make an appointment with him. Do not take any chance with your immortal soul!

By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Thrones, may the Lord infuse into our hearts a true and sincere spirit of humility. Amen. +++ IV. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Dominations, may the Lord give us grace to govern our senses and overcome any unruly passions. Amen. +++ V. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Virtues, may the Lord preserve us from evil and falling into temptation. Amen. +++ VI. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Powers, may the Lord protect our souls against the snares and temptations of the devil. Amen. +++ VII. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Principalities, may God fill our souls with a true spirit of obedience. Amen. +++ VIII. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Archangels, may the Lord give us perseverance in faith and in all good works in order that we may attain the glory of Heaven. Amen. +++ IX. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Angels, may the Lord grant us to be protected by them in this mortal life and conducted in the life to come to Heaven. Amen.

Say one Our Father in honor of each of the following leading Angels: St. Michael, St. Gabriel, St. Raphael and our Guardian Angel.

Concluding prayers: O glorious prince St. Michael, chief and commander of the heavenly hosts, guardian of souls, vanquisher of rebel spirits, servant in the house of the Divine King and our admirable conductor, you who shine with excellence and superhuman virtue deliver us from all evil, who turn to you with confidence and enable us by your gracious protection to serve God more and more faithfully every day.

Pray for us, O glorious St. Michael, Prince of the Church of Jesus Christ, that we may be made worthy of His promises.
