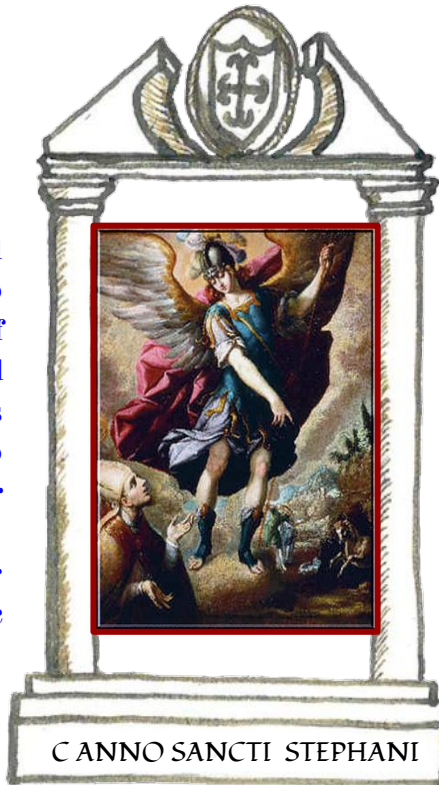


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

CHAPLET OF ST. MICHAEL

Begin the Chaplet by praying the following invocation on the medal:

O God, come to my aid. O Lord, make haste to help me.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

After each Salutation, recite the Our Father once and the Hail Mary three times in honor of the corresponding Choir of Angels.

FIRST SALUTATION

Ruby

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of SERAPHIM, may it please God to make us worthy to receive into our hearts the fire of His perfect charity. Amen.

SECOND SALUTATION

Sapphire

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of CHERUBIM, may God grant us the grace to abandon the ways of sin and to follow the path of Christian perfection. Amen.

THIRD SALUTATION

Amethyst

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of THRONES, may it please God to infuse into our hearts a true and earnest spirit of humility. Amen.

FOURTH SALUTATION

Crystal

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of DOMINATIONS, may it please God to grant us the grace to have dominion over our senses, and to correct our depraved passions. Amen.

FIFTH SALUTATION

Garnet

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of VIRTUES, may Our Lord keep us from falling into temptation and deliver us from evil. Amen.

SIXTH SALUTATION

Aquamarine

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of POWERS, may God vouchsafe to keep our souls from the wiles and temptations of the devil. Amen.

SEVENTH SALUTATION

Emerald

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of PRINCIPALITIES, may it please God to fill our hearts with the spirit of true and hearty obedience. Amen.

EIGHTH SALUTATION

Aurora Borealis

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of ARCHANGELS, may it please God to grant us the grace of perseverance in the faith and in all good works, that we may thereby be enabled to attain unto the glory of Paradise. Amen.

NINTH SALUTATION

Topaz

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the Celestial Choir of ANGELS, may God vouchsafe to grant that they may protect us during life, and after death may lead us into the everlasting glory of Heaven. Amen.

Then pray the Our Father four times in conclusion on the appropriate beads: the first in honor of ST. MICHAEL, the second in honor of ST. GABRIEL, the third in honor of ST. RAPHAEL, and the fourth in honor of your GUARDIAN ANGEL. Then conclude with the following:

SAINT Michael, glorious Prince, chief and champion of the Heavenly Host, guardian of the souls of men, conqueror of the rebellious angels, steward of the Palace of God under Our Divine King Jesus Christ; our worthy leader, endowed with superhuman excellence and virtue: vouchsafe to free us from all evil, who with full confidence have recourse to thee; and by thy incomparable protection, enable us to make progress every day in the faithful services of Our God. Amen.

Pray for us, most blessed Michael, Prince of the Church of Jesus Christ. That we may be made worthy of His promises.

Let us pray: ALMIGHTY and Eternal God, Who in Thine Own marvelous goodness and pity, didst, for the common salvation of men, choose the glorious Archangel Michael, to be the Prince of Thy Church: make us worthy, we pray Thee, to be delivered by his beneficent protection from all our enemies, that, at the hour of our death, none of them may approach to harm us; rather do Thou vouchsafe unto us that, by the same Archangel Michael, we may be introduced into the Presence of Thy Most High and Divine Majesty. Through the Merits of the same Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.
