FIRST COMMUNION - All parents whose children are preparing to make their First Holy Communion on June 11th, on the Extended Feast of Corpus Christi, please talk to the Canon to set up the things that need to be done in preparation. Do not expect your child to be a Theologian. Knowledge of the Basics and prayers and of the Sacraments is sufficient.

FATHERS' DAY - On the table in the Foyer are the envelopes to request remembrance at the Masses for Fathers' Day and for a month thereafter. Please type or print the names clearly. Make all checks to the Rev. Canon.

THEOLOGY CLASS - We will have Theology Class next Wednesday at 7 PM after Mass, in the Canon Pérez Hall.

FIRST CONFESSION AND COMMUNION - Our children will make their First Confession on Saturday June 10th after Mass. They will also be tested. First Communion is the next day, Sunday June 11th.

OUR LADY'S ANTIPHON

(From the Regina Coeli used at Paschal Time we now start the Antiphon used during most of the year after Trinity Sunday. Particularly used at the end of Compline at night before retiring for the day.)

Salve, Regina, Mater misericordiae; vita, dulcedo et spes nostra, salve. Ad te clamamus exules filii Evae. Ad te suspiramus gementes et flentes in hac lacrimarum valle. Eia ergo, advocata nostra, illos tuos misericordes oculos ad nos converte. Et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui, nobis post hoc exilium ostende. O clemens, o pia, o dulcis Virgo Maria.

We also return to reciting the Angelus three times a day.
