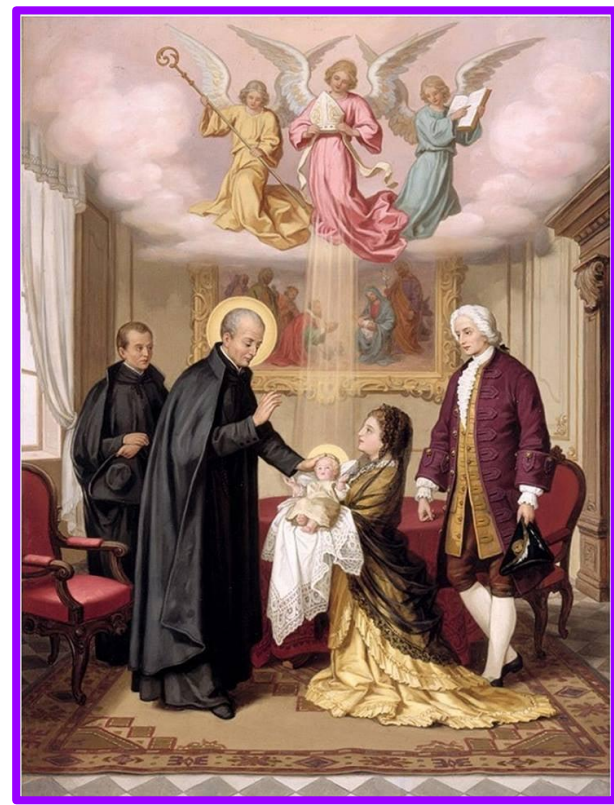

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION - The Solemn Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Mother is fast approaching. August 15th there will be a High Mass at 6 PM. ALL Acolytes and Schola members are asked to be present.

PROPER ATTIRE - We ask that EVERYONE who enters into the Holy House of God, which this holy Temple is, be properly dressed. No shorts, sleeveless dresses or shirts; no beach or picnic wear should ever be worn here. Not just on Sundays, but NEVER. Please be so kind as to respect our rules.

PARENTS - In your charity, please make sure the children do not play and tear the hymnals in the pews, or the pews themselves with keys and hard toys. Only bring stuffed toys to the Church. These things make our Church beautiful and are very expensive to replace.
