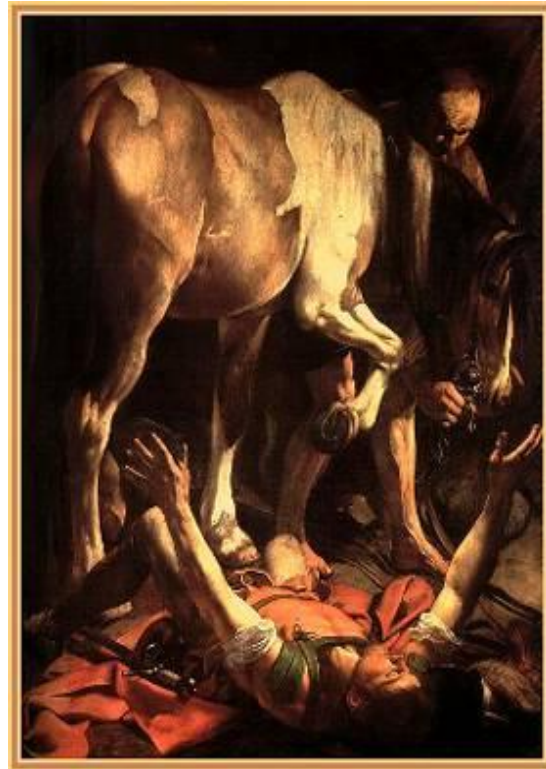


## WELCOME TO THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY

**VOLUNTEERS** - We will need volunteers to help take down the decorations in the Hall, the Shrine and all around beginning on Monday, February 5th, after the celebration of the Presentation and the end of the Forty Days of Christmas. We thank you in advance!

**ANOINTING** - As usual, V. Rev. Canon will be conferring the Sacrament of Unction (Anointing of the Sick) after the 4PM Mass on Saturday, February 10th in honor of Our Lady of Lourdes' Feast on the 11th. Please try to go to Confession before that. Only Catholics who are seriously or chronically ill, and all those over 60 are eligible. This goes back to the Apostolic times, see the Epistle of the Apostle St. James.

**TIME CHANGE** - After consultation with many, Canon Pérez has decided to change the time of the Saturday morning Mass and Novena from 8 AM to 8:30 AM. This will hopefully make it easier for many who live at a distance to come. This is the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. It is most important that we honor her. We will start on Feb. 3rd, First Saturday.

**HOLY NAME RAFFLE** - We remind ALL that the Annual Holy Name Raffle will be taking place on Candlemas Day, February 2nd at the Reception after the EVENING Mass and other ceremonies. Each family or employed individual is asked to buy or sell 100 tickets. For those who get more than 200, you will receive a paver at the outdoor St. Stephen Shrine in the front. The Raffle has enabled us to do so many things here. Please continue to help us!

**CALENDARS** - The usual Calendars for all the important events and dates for our Shrine are available now. Please, EVERYONE, especially Schola; Acolytes (and their parents) take one and keep them in sight. We do want as many as possible to participate in everything!!
