ANOINTING - As usual, V. Rev. Canon will be conferring the Sacrament of Unction (Anointing of the Sick) after the 4PM Mass on Saturday, February 10th in honor of Our Lady of Lourdes' Feast on the 11th. Please try to go to Confession before that. Only Catholics who are seriously or chronically ill, and all those over 60 are eligible. This goes back to the Apostolic times, see the Epistle of the Apostle St. James.

SEPTUAGESIMA AND LENT - In the Gregorian Rite and Calendar (Martyrology) we begin this Sunday with the pre-Lenten season of Septuagesima. This means some changes in the Liturgy (no Alleluias, et.), purple vestments unless otherwise specified, and more opportunities for fasting and penance. More information next week.

TIME CHANGE - After consultation with many, Canon Pérez has decided to change the time of the Saturday morning Mass and Novena from 8 AM to 8:30 AM. This will hopefully make it easier for many who live at a distance to come. This is the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. It is most important that we honor her. We will start on Feb. 3rd, First Saturday.
