Please try to go to Confession before that. Only Catholics who are seriously or chronically ill, and all those over 60 are eligible. This goes back to the Apostolic times, see the Epistle of the Apostle St. James.

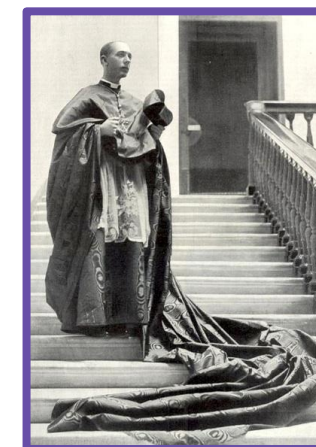

"On the Threshold of Eternity - the Sacrament of Unction

Formerly, Holy Anointing, the completion, as it were of the Sacrament of Penance, preceded as a rule Holy Viaticum; but these three Sacraments were commonly received, not indeed at the last hour of life, as is the corrupt custom in these later times, but even before the sick person's condition gave any cause for anxiety. Nor is the mind of the Church in this matter in any way changed today, as is shown by the Tridentine Decree, and the contrary abuse is justly condemned as harmful, for this reason also that the grace of the Sacrament operates to the benefit of the bodily health of the sick; not indeed by effecting a miraculous resurrection of a dead body, snatched from the very jaws of death, but *per modum medicinae*, at a time when it is still humanly possible to cure the sick person and restore him to health. Thus it was that in the Middle Ages, as in the East today, the Sacrament of Unction was very often conferred publicly in church, whilst the sick person remained seated or else knelt before the Priest...
