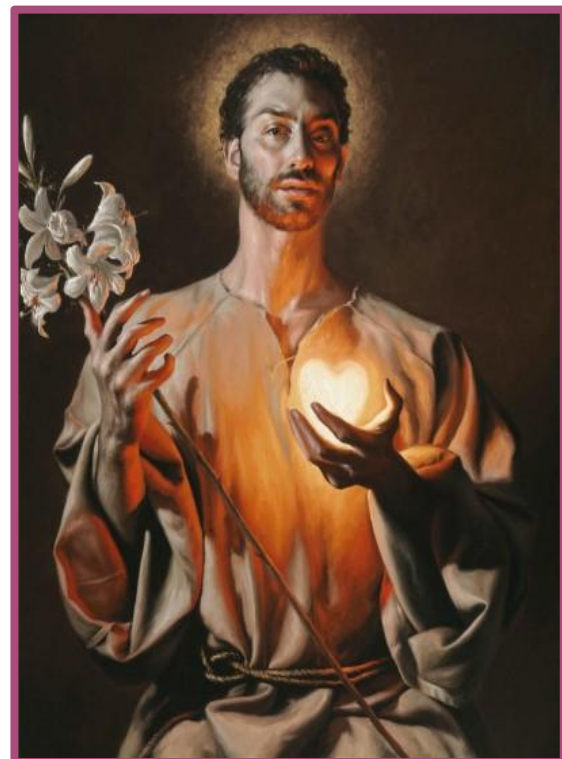


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY

3. Jesus lost in the Temple
4. Mary meets Jesus on the Way to Calvary
5. Jesus is crucified and dies on the Cross
6. Jesus is taken down from the Cross
7. Jesus is laid in the sepulchre.

These "mysteries" of Our Lady's Sorrows may be accompanied by an Our Father and seven Hail Mary's each. It is a lovely and efficacious devotion always, but especially during Lent and Passiontide.
