PENANCE - As is the Canon Law of the Church for centuries, ALL Catholics must go to Confession during the season of Lent and Easter - thus the term "Easter Duty". This period ends with the Eve of Trinity Sunday, which is May 26 this year.

SACRAMENTS - We remind all the parents of children slated to make their First Holy Communion in June to contact Canon for the requirements. Best by email. Remember, he doesn't open emails after 2 PM. Test, practice, and First Confession will be on June 1st; First Communion on Sunday, June 2nd. We will also be celebrating Rev. Canon's Anniversary of Ordination

Remember, this day and every 13th of all months are Plenary Indulgence days for all who come to pray to Our Lady here.
