PENANCE - As is the Canon Law of the Church for centuries, ALL Catholics must go to Confession during the season of Lent and Easter - thus the term "Easter Duty". This period ends with the Eve of Trinity Sunday, which is May 26 this year.

ANNUNCIATION - Because of Holy Week and the Octave of Easter which take precedence, the Solemnity of the Annunciation will be celebrated TOMORROW, April 8. It is the Incarnation of the Son of God in the Womb of the Blessed Ever-Virgin Mary.

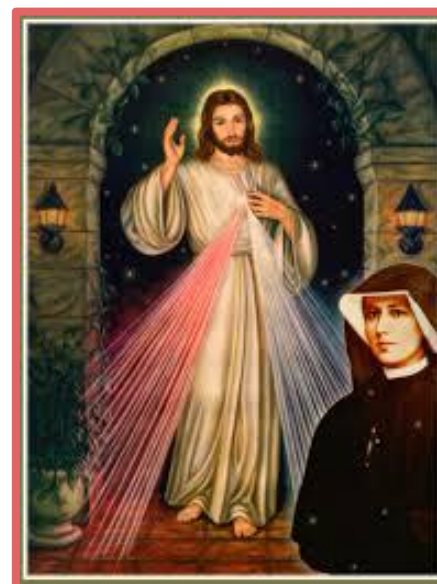
