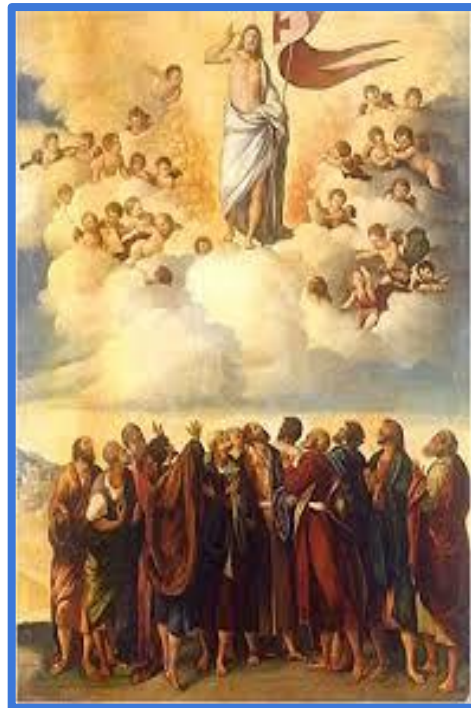


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY

SACRAMENTS - We remind all parents of children slated to make their First Holy Communion in June to contact Canon for the requirements. Best by email. Remember, he doesn't open emails after 2 PM. Test, practice, and First Confession will be on June 1st; First Communion on Sunday, June 2nd. We will also be celebrating Rev. Canon's Anniversary of Ordination. Please email Canon if you need more information.

EASTER DUTY - As has been mentioned many times before, ALL Catholics must go to Confession at least once a year (monthly or more so is recommended). The dates are from Ash Wednesday to the Vigil of the Feast of the Holy Trinity (May 25 this year). One must also receive Holy Communion once a year during that time - but only in the State of Grace.

CSA - We have already made our quota for the CSA 2024 so anything you donate from now on goes to our savings account. Be as generous as you can! Thanks!

NOVENA - The yearly Novena to the Holy Spirit begins the day after the Ascension, May 10, and continues until Pentecost. There are copies inserted into the bulletin as well as available in the pews. (Ushers do not collect). If you cannot be here please pray it at home. It is the most important Novena!

MAY CROWNING - As is our Tradition here at the Shrine the little girls of our Shrine will crown the statue of Our Lady of Fatima, made for us from local wood from Fatima, that is on our Altar. All the girls are invited. White or blue dresses and white mantillas are desired. We will practice THIS Sunday after the High Mass.

ASCENSION - The Solemn Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven is THIS Thursday, May 9th. For Traditional Catholics it is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass here will be at 6 PM. Rosary at 5:30. Acolytes and Schola please be present. After Mass we will have the usual Novena to the Holy Infant of Prague and Benediction - grace upon grace!

MOTHER'S DAY - The annual day of prayer for all our Mothers will be NEXT Sunday, May 12th. Remembrance envelopes are in the Foyer. Reverend Canon will remember them each day on the Altar all until Father's Day in June.

FATIMA DAY - We will celebrate the 107th Anniversary of the First Apparition of Our Lady at Fatima on Monday, May 13th, with Mass, Rosary, and Novena to Our Lady with Benediction. Everyone is asked to please be here and honor Our Patroness. Mass will be in the evening, at 6 PM. Rosary at 5:30. Remember, this day and every 13th of all months are Plenary Indulgence days for all who come to pray to Our Lady here.
