OUR LADY OF OROPA

The most ancient, continuously existing, Shrine of Our Lady is at the foot of Mt. Oropa in the lower Italian Alps, near the town of Pollone and the city of Biella. All of these have a close association with the famed Father of the Church and Bishop, St. Eusebius of Vercelli. In the fourth century, when the Church was in splinters as a result of the heresy of Arianism, St. Eusebius, Bishop of Vercelli was sent in exile. He went to the Holy Land where he saved as many precious Relics as he could; among them the Image of Our Lady, said to have been sculpted by none other than St. Luke. When he was able to return to Vercelli, he took the precious statue to a small monastery of monks he had established at the foot of Mt. Oropa. There she was enshrined in a chapel in a cave where she is still today. Bd. Pier Giorgio Frassati, whose family summer home was at nearby Pollone, would climb the mountain to visit Our Lady there very often. When he was beatified, his incorrupt body was brought to Oropa for a few days before being taken to the Cathedral of Turin. Many miracles have been ascribed to this precious Image of Our Lady seen as if at the Presentation with the prescribed Offering for the Temple. It is also one of my favorite Italian Marian Shrines where I have been privileged to offer Holy Mass right before Our Lady's Image. Her movable Feast is observed on a Saturday in August.
