HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION - We remind everyone that THIS Thursday, August 15th, the Glorious Assumption of the ever-blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven, is a Holy Day of Obligation. ALL Catholics are expected to assist at Holy Mass that day. The High Mass, here, will be at 6 PM following the Holy Rosary. Because it is Thursday, it will be accompanied by Novena to the Most Holy Infant of Prague and Benediction. Plan to be here. What a blessed day! Where She is we hope to follow! It is a Plenary Indulgence Day here at Her Shrine.

PLENARY INDULGENCE - This month we are thrice blessed. We can obtain the Plenary Indulgence on: the 13th, Fatima Day as each month; the Assumption on the 15th; and also on the 22nd, Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary; and the 26th, Our Lady of Czestochowa. Prayer for Priests and Vocations

As some may not know or remember the prayer which we say here after the Fatima Prayer at the end of each decade of the Holy Rosary, we reproduce it here for your convenience in English and in Latin:

God, Our Father, please send us holy Priests. All for the Sacred and Eucharistic Heart of Jesus. All through the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, in union with St. Joseph!

Pater noster, Domine Deus, sanctos nobis dignare mittere Sacerdotes. Omnia pro Sacratissimo ac Eucharistico Corde Iesu. Omnia per Dolorosissimum ac Immaculatum Cor Mariae, in unione Sancti Ioseph!
